## **Presentation**

 Community Power Program presented by Henry Herndon, Director of Member Services, Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire

New Hampshire's Community Power market is taking off. In 2023, more than a dozen cities and towns and one county launched Community Power programs working with the nonprofit power supplier Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (CPCNH). Roughly 85,000 customers in these communities will realize ~\$10 million in savings from lower electric rates well within the first year of service. CPCNH expands local control over energy decisions by ensuring accountability and transparency in power supply. In the North Country, Androscoggin Valley Energy Collaborative is forming a Community Power Program to serve Berlin, Randolph, Shelburne, and other towns in the region.
