Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Applications

- ► The CMAQ program is a federally funded reimbursement program that provides up to 80% of funds for projects that improve air quality by reducing the amount of vehicular emissions. There is approximately \$30 million total dollars available for this round. Funding is targeted for federal fiscal years 2025 through 2028.
- 3 CMAQ Applications were Submitted:
 - Berlin
 - Franconia
 - ► Glen & Mt. Washington Stage Company

Notes on CMAQ Projects

- Note: NHDOT has decided to shift all EV Charger Infrastructure funding to be looked at separately at a later date.
- ► The Franconia application will be put aside until the review process for EV Charging Projects is determined by NHDOT.
- Berlin Application will be reviewed for its Clean Vehicle Fleet purchases, charging infrastructure will be reviewed later with other EV Charging Applications.

Berlin Public Schools - SAU 3

- Purpose: Replace four (4) older diesel buses in the fleet (model years 2010-2013) with four (4) fully electric buses and charging stations.
- Eventual Goal is to transition entire fleet from Diesel to electric.
- ▶ Initial estimate of a reduction of 270,000 pounds of emissions per year.
- ▶ Will result in cleaner air quality for community, staff, and students
- Project Amount: \$1,580,000
 - ► Federal: \$1,264,000 (80%)
 - ► Local: \$316,000 (20%)
- Documents: Letter of support, Maintenance Schedule for fleet vehicles
- Rank: 1 (Score of 60)
- Used points/scoring system on Application form to score and determine a rank

- Company to contract initial retrofit/conversion activity and then be maintained by staff.
- Project Amount: \$90,000
 - ► Federal: \$72,000
 - Match: \$18,000
- Rank: 2 (Score of 45)

Ten Year Plan Projects

- After the submittal of projects in November, NHDOT staff created a working group to review and comment on all of the submitted Ten-Year Plan projects statewide. The committee met to discuss the projects and consider implementation issues including:
 - The assumptions related to work required to carry out the project scope.
 - ► The estimated costs for Engineering (PE), Right-of-Way (ROW) and Construction (CON).
 - Estimated schedule to carry out the work to accomplish the proposed project and plan financially.
- ► Today: We will review the projects again, along with the NHDOT comments, and determine if we need to reprioritize the projects, and which to officially submit to the state
- Our Regional Allocation: \$7,180,998

Priority 1 - Shelburne: US 2 Resiliency Improvements

- Project Summary: To Reduce the Risk of flooding along US-2 due to large rainfall events.
- Summary of Comments:
 - Aquatic Remediation must be factored in
 - Would FEMA Flood map revisions be necessary?
 - Increased estimated construction cost factoring in full-depth construction
 - Increased Preliminary Engineering to reflect cost with similar projects
 - Added funding to ROW phase due to additional investigation possible needed.

Priority 2 - Gorham Installation of Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvements on NH16

- Project Summary: Provide pedestrian and Bicycle facilities along NH-16 between Lydia's Golden Touch and the Walmart Supercenter
- Summary of Comments:
 - Minimal comments, conceptual estimate is in line with similar projects statewide.
 - Added \$50,000 to ROW phase due to ROW along project boundary appearing on private property where sidewalk proposed.
 - ► A municipal agreement will need to be executed prior to commencing the project for maintenance obligations
 - Project would be split 80/20 (Federal and local)

Priority 3 - Randolph Widening of US-2 for Left Turn Lane

- Project Summary: The purpose of this project is to provide a left-turn lane on US-2 into Randolph Hill Road, while maintaining the existing passing lane in the eastbound direction
- Summary of Comments:
 - Minimal comments due to conceptual estimate of construction costs in line with similar projects
 - Pavement under the shoulder may need to be rebuilt and thus could impact final project costs
 - ROW costs were increased due to some proposed slope work appears out of ROW and may incur additional costs/timeline changes

Priority 4 - Conway Improvements to Intersection at NH16 and Intervale Cross Rd

- Project Summary: Improve safety and operations at NH-16 and Intervale Cross Road for all roadway users. Project currently designed with a roundabout.
- Summary of Comments:
 - Project Purpose and need must involve a review of a reasonable list of alternatives
 - Proposed Cost of Roundabout appears reasonable
 - Concerns on the diameter of roundabout to accommodate larger vehicles using truck route
 - Issues might exist due to impacts to scenic overlook
 - Increased ROW funds due to need for public hearing and possible acquisitions
- NHDOT Comment Letter contains inaccurate estimates.
